



Discipline appeal process

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If a player feels like discipline brought against them is unfair, they may utilize the following steps to request an appeal.

1. The player requesting an appeal outlines the issue with the decision and what their desired results of the appeal are via email to the Executive Officers.
 - a. The Executive Officers respond to the appeal request, within one week, as to whether it will be granted or not. The Executive Officers have the right to deny an appeal. Should the Executive Officers deny the appeal, they must explain their reasoning as to why the appeal was denied via email.
2. If an appeal is granted, the Executive Officers provide a list of accusations made against the player and the names of those that were involved with the accusations.
3. The Player requests, via email, a meeting with the Operations Team to discuss their perspective on the decision made and the accusations that were laid against them.
 - a. The player may provide a list of witnesses, at least one week prior to the scheduled meeting, for the Executive Officers to contact about the situation.
 - i. All communication will be documented for later review.
 - b. The player may request the attendance of an advocate of their choosing at the meeting.
4. After the player is given their appeal meeting, the Operations Team will make their decision and the Executive Officers will inform the player via email within one week.
