



Rules of Conduct and Offenses Policy Update

- A general Incident Form has been created for reporting specific incidents to the Staff at Legacies LARP. Incident Report forms will be provided at event and online which will help all players if they are unsure who to report an incident to or are uncomfortable reporting an incident in-person. If you have difficulty filling out forms, assistance will be provided upon request.
- A new Disciplinary System has been created to replace the Ref warning System:
 - **Minor Violations** – Result: 1 Minor warning along with the nature of the violation marked on the player’s character sheet. Examples include:
 - Intentionally ignoring damage calls or significantly inflating your character’s ability to take damage (known as “Rhino-hiding”).
 - Frequently ignoring abilities used on them.
 - Obvious and proven metagaming that detract from another player's experience.
 - Pulling a significant number of players out-of-game for an extended period of time will receive 2 prior warnings before it becomes a full violation that will receive a Minor warning and the violation marked on the player's character sheet.

New players have a 3 month grace period in which they are exempt from receiving minor warnings. They will instead receive immediate coaching should they commit an infraction which would otherwise warrant a minor warning.

- **Moderate Violations** – Result: 1 Moderate warning and denied Blanket for the event along with the nature of the violation marked on the player’s character sheet. Examples include:
 - Knowingly using skills that are not on your character sheet.
 - Knowingly using more skill uses than your character has.
 - Physical roleplay without consent.
 - Endangering the safety of others through your own actions (example: Physical roleplay during combat).
 - Acting in a referee capacity outside of your official position(s) or without a referee position at all.
- **Major Violations** – Result: 1 Major warning, denied Blanket for the event, the nature of the violation marked on the player’s character sheet, and the possibility of a temporary suspension or ban from attending future events pending an investigation. Examples include:
 - Forging tags.
 - Knowingly exchanging tags, coin, or magic items between your character slots.
 - Violation of the Anti-Bullying and Harrassment policy

Additional Details:

- If you receive 3 or more Minor warnings in one month, you do not receive Blanket for that event.
- After 3 months have passed without receiving any additional warnings existing warnings will be removed at a rate of one per month. Warnings removed in this manner will be removed in the order which they were received. Note that Major violations include the possibility of a temporary suspension from attending game, and existing warnings will stay on your card while you are suspended.
- Upon receiving 5 total warnings of any type you lose the ability to NPC until all your warnings have expired and your case will be reviewed to determine if any further action is required.
- Violations from staff members will be reviewed by the Heads of Staff regarding the severity and whether they should be stripped of their position(s). If the staff member is removed from their position(s) in this way they will be ineligible from holding any game positions for a determined duration depending upon the severity of the violations.

- **Serious Offenses**

In addition to the violations listed above, certain Serious Offenses have their own consequences. Disciplinary action for serious offenses applies to all players, however, if a staff member is found to have committed any of the following they will be immediately stripped of any organization position and will become unable to hold a position at Legacies LARP for 1 year. Serious Offenses include:

- **Threats of violence against another player** – Result: 1 Major warning, Blanket denied, and the possibility of a 3-month, or longer, suspension from attending events pending an investigation into the incident.
- **Violence against another player not in self-defense** – Result: Immediate ejection from game and the possibility of a 6-month, or longer, suspension from attending events pending investigation into the incident.
- **Possession of an intoxicating substance** – Result: Immediate ejection from game with the possibility of a 3-month, or longer, suspension from attending events pending an investigation into the incident.
- **Stealing from another player out-of-game** – Result: Immediate ejection from game with the possibility of a 3-month, or longer, suspension from attending events pending investigation.

- **Additional Information:**

- For all investigations, Executive Officers and/or Referees may request more witnesses in order to get more accounts of the incident.
- If you witness a violation and are not a Referee, please report the violation to any Referee immediately or submit an official incident report.
- If you witness an incident and are unsure if it is a violation because it is not listed in any of the scenarios above, please report it to a Referee immediately and we will investigate the incident.
- If an investigation reveals that a warning was not justified, it will be removed immediately.
